- All organized tennis play is under the City of Sandpoint Parks & Recreation Department.
- Players must be 16 or older. Legal guardian must sign waiver if under 18.
- Players that reside within the City of Sandpoint limits receive a discount (they pay city taxes above those paid by players outside City Limits).
- Sandpoint Tennis Association (STA) membership is \$25-see attached form. It's cheaper to join STA directly than pay non-STA registration fees. Current STA status will be confirmed.
- Singles play is the week of May 31st – July 11th. Play schedule will be mailed.
- Doubles play is May 19th – August 12th (Wednesday eves. & poss. Tuesdays if needed). Play schedule will be mailed.
- Doubles extended play is Aug. 18th – Sept. 30th (Wednesday evenings & poss. Tuesdays if needed). Play schedule will be mailed.

DO NOT READ THESE RULES AT YOUR OWN RISK

Play is limited to the first 64 registered players

- A. Eligibility - All players must complete registration form and liability release through Sandpoint Parks & Recreation Department. Please note that current STA Members receive a considerable discount.
All players must be 16 yrs of age or older.
- B. Time of play
 1. Matches will be played every Wednesday and if necessary also on Tuesday. The tennis courts are posted reserved beginning at 5pm. Warm up 5:00 p.m. – 5:30 p.m. Play begins at 5:30 p.m.
 2. Inclement weather will be the only reason for canceling a match. Rainouts will not be made-up.
- C. Rules of play
 1. All matches will be played in accordance with U.S.T.A. rules.
 2. 3 sets played per match. Players will furnish their own tennis balls.
 3. Regular season play will be from May 19th thru August 12th and extended season from Aug. 18th thru Sept. 30th. The schedule for the first day will be mailed to each regular and sub player. After week #1, individuals will move up or down one court depending on scoring (see scoring below). This rotation format will continue throughout the season.
 4. Players will vacate the court promptly at the end of play if another STA match is scheduled.
 5. For scheduling purposes, players are **REQUIRED** to post their scores on the clipboards hanging at the courts, once their matches are completed.
 6. After completion of the first week of play, it might be necessary to reassign (readjust) some players to different courts. If so, this will be done by the league coordinator.
 7. If a player needs a sub: Call the coordinator @ 263-5513 or Jim Parsons @ 290-7448. Players are not to secure their own subs this season.
 8. If a sub fails to show up for a scheduled match, they forfeit their right to remain on the sub list and their name will be removed...UNLESS... they inform the coordinator or Jim Parsons with sufficient notice.
 9. **Any player, who signs up for the regular tennis season and misses the first two weeks, will automatically be placed on the sub list until an opening near their rating becomes available. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
 10. If a player misses 3 consecutive weeks or a total of 4 weeks, they will be placed on the sub list.
- D. Scoring
 1. Scoring is determined by the total games, you as an individual, win. Three sets are played per match, each set with a different player on your court. Your score will be the total number of GAMES you win.
 2. The player with the highest score will move up one court for the following week and the player with the lowest score will drop down one court for the following week. Ties will be broken with a racquet spin.
 3. *If a player uses a sub, the following applies: The sub will keep score on the same clipboard sheet as the other players. If the sub turns in the lowest score, the player subbed for goes down one court. But, a player cannot advance using a sub, even if the subs score is the highest. In this event the second highest score will advance.*

E. Courts / Play

You will be mailed a first round match schedule and court designation. Please make sure that you BEGIN PLAY at the scheduled START TIME. That DOES NOT mean that you begin warm-up at the start time.

Sandpoint Parks & Recreation Dept. / Sandpoint Tennis Association 2009 ~ format and rules for singles league

1. The league will be Sunday, May 31st through Saturday, July 11th (6 weeks). Matches will be best of 3 sets. A second session could be offered if there is enough interest in continuing.
2. The number of participants will determine the division of levels. We plan on having at least two. Players will declare their own rating and the Parks & Recreation Department will create the leagues. If we do not receive enough participants to make two divisions we will combine or cancel and refund per the decision of the Parks & Rec. Department. Every effort to avoid lopsided matches will be made.
3. Participants will play one match per week. The player line up will be determined by a random drawing. A scheduled week is Sunday through Saturday. If a player cannot play his/her match during the week that it is scheduled, due to vacation, weather, or illness they will be required to make up that match within two weeks. If it is determined that a participant has consistently failed to schedule or show up for his/her matches, they will not be allowed to participate in future singles leagues of this format. **Success of this style of play depends on the players.**
4. The day, time, and location of the match will be scheduled by phone and agreed upon by the two players prior to the start of the week scheduled to be play. All players are asked to be as flexible as possible when scheduling matches.
5. Each match would have one player designated as host. The designation of host will be made on an equitable basis. The host's responsibilities are: (A) Provide one can of new balls. (B) Initiate contact with the opposing player. (Although if you have not heard from your host/opponent you should call him/her). (C) The host will call the Singles League Coordinator and report the results of each match. In case of a tiebreaker the games scores should also be given.
